Early Reading and Phonics at Queens' Crescent School

This year we have launched our new Phonics Program: Unlocking Letters and Sounds (ULS). All teachers and TA's across the school have attended an accredited training session for ULS and the children are now familiar with the wonderful new resources that we use alongside it in class. All children in FS2 and KS1 receive daily phonics lessons where they are taught and have opportunities to practise the necessary skills for reading and spelling. These lessons are pacey and fun and in FS2 and Y1 you will find home learning tasks on SeeSaw to help celebrate and consolidate the week's learning. This year we have been selected to be a Partner School of The Ramsbury English Hub. This means that teachers and TA's will be working alongside Early Literacy Specialists to continue to deliver high quality early reading and phonics lessons. Last academic year, our Phonics Screening results were above both the National and the Wiltshire averages and we are sure that this partnership will help to ensure standards remain high in these areas for the current and future children of Queen's Crescent. As a Partner School, we are eligible for 'Match Funding' of new resources to support ULS. Following a Group and Individual Reading Book audit, we are now eagerly awaiting delivery of some wonderful new books for the children to enjoy at home and in school. This year as we "return to normal school functioning", we will be hosting in person workshops for individual year groups so please do come along to these when they are advertised.
