Hobbit Hut

Passports

Owing to changes in passport procedures, that require the personal details of staff to be given as part of the process, and a growing concern nationally about holidays being taken in term time, an agreement has been made amongst all of the local Chippenham Town Schools and we will unfortunately not be able to support with this moving forward.

<u>Dojo Points</u>



Over the next few days your child may talk about earning a 'Dojo' for positive behaviour. We want to explain what they are, why we are using them and how your child can earn them.

As a school, we are introducing a consistent whole school approach to rewarding positive behaviours. To do this we are using a dojo point system. Dojo points are awarded for effort and/or following school rules. The children will have plenty of

opportunities to earn dojo points on a daily basis. The children collect dojo points and when they have collected a set amount they will earn an extra reward.

House Teams

As part of our new behaviour policy (available on the school website), we are also re-introducing House Teams. All children and staff will belong to one of six house groups:

Each week, every child will have their total number of dojo points added to the rest of the children's points in their house. The house with the highest total of dojos at the end of each term will be rewarded with a 'House treat'.

Throughout the year we will also hold House Team challenges.

For this reason, we kindly ask that the children do not bring nuts in for a snack or as part of their packed lunches. Thank you for your help with this.
