
Dear Parents and Carers,

We are really looking forward to once again being able to invite our families back into school for our Christmas performances and being able to spread a bit of Christmas cheer.

Class Name Changes

Over the last year, the School Councillors have been tasked with collecting ideas for themes to change the names of the classes at Queen's Crescent. The class names are currently named after Local Streets, which are named after British Race Course. We thought it time for a change and the School Council have really risen to the challenge, collecting lots of fantastic ideas from their classmates holding a vote to decide on the winning theme. The favourite theme by some margin was words from "The Lost Words book". The School Council then had the final decision on the words chosen from the book. The new class names are as below:

To mark the change of the names, which comes into play from the first day back after Christmas, the children will spend the day completing learning based on the lost words book and their classes new name. The day will start with a special assembly where each class will receive a copy of the book and a signed postcard from the author. Following on over the course of term 3, each class will be writing poetry based on the lost words. There has also been a competition running for the children to design a new door sign for their classrooms, the winners will be announced in assembly and turned into a brand-new sign for the classroom door.

Attendance



We wanted to take this opportunity to remind you of our duty to ensure that al children attend school during term time whenever they are fit and well enough to do so. Leave of absence requests will only be granted in exceptional circumstances. We have noticed an increase in leave of absence requests over the course of the autumn term and also increased levels of non-attendance. We therefore felt it important to remind our families that Wiltshire Council may issue Penalty Notices for truancy

(unauthorised absence) as well as for unauthorised leave of absence (holiday). If a pupil accumulates 10 or more sessions of unauthorised absence or unauthorised leave of absence within a specified 6 month period the school must notify the Local Authority and a Penalty Notice will be issued to each parent for each child where that applies.

A penalty of £120 will apply, if paid within 21 days this is reduced to £60. £120 21-28 days. If after 28 days the penalty has not been paid, legal proceedings will be taken through the magistrates' court for the unauthorised absence.
